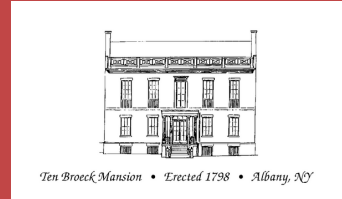

The People of Prospect: An Exploration of the Historic Ten Broeck Mansion

Did you know that Abraham Ten Broeck was a Brigadier General in the American Revolution? Or that his wife, Elizabeth Van Rensselaer, was a member of one of the oldest and wealthiest Dutch families in New York? Join us in travelling back in time to Colonial Albany and learn about the people who lived in Prospect, an estate built by one of Albany's most prominent residents, Abraham Ten Broeck.

As students enter Prospect, they will be transported back over 200 years! Educators will invite them to explore the experiences of all the home's residents, including free and enslaved woman, children and men. Students will learn how the stories of these people connect to the larger story of Albany and our nation.
